### **Improving Our School**

**School Improvement Plan Priority 2:** To improve the use of digital technology to enhance learning and to develop children's digital and employability skills



### How are we working to achieve this?

- Teachers took part in professional learning in computer science during the August in-service days.
- ◆ During the course of the school year, all children will experience computer science lessons appropriate to their age and stage, specifically using: Bebots in P1—P3 classes; Kodu software in P4 & P5 and Scratch software in P6 & P7.
- Teachers are using digital technology to enhance learning and teaching across the curriculum, including Sumdog for numeracy. Sumdog log-ins have been provided for P children to allow children and parents to access this activity at home.
- We have purchased a wireless router which is providing access to the internet using laptops in class-
- ♦ P6 & P7 children participated in a World of Work day when they had the opportunity to meet representatives of a wide variety of occupations.
