

From the Head Teacher's desk

ur children continue to do us proud both in school and in the wider community. The dance squad have qualified for the City of Dance 2017 finals in the Royal Concert Hall on 8 June, the football team are playing a cup semi-final next week (details overleaf) and the choir led the singing beautifully at the P7 Mass with Archbishop Philip in St Andrew's Cathedral.

As I have mentioned in previous newsletters, schools are receiving significant additional funding from the Scottish Government to raise attainment. How St Brigid's will spend our share of the money will form the basis of our school improvement plan for next year. The main interventions are firmly focused on the development of children's literacy and numeracy skills. Parents will have additional opportunities to be involved in their children's learning both during school time and after school and we will continue to give children as many before or after school opportunities as possible. We intend to purchase a mobile wireless router to allow us to make better use of the laptops we already have. A family support worker will be shared with another school. We know from research that it is high quality staff that makes the biggest different to children's learning and so have chosen to invest in appointing two additional acting principal teachers with specific responsibility for raising attainment. I am delighted to inform you that Mrs Moretti and Mr Keddilty have been appointed as acting principal teachers. In addition, Mrs R O'Neill's principal teacher post is being enhanced to PT grade 2 with additional responsibilities. Having a larger management team will allow us to provide teachers, children and parents with considerable additional support.

Mrs Walsh will return from maternity leave at the beginning of the new session and is reducing her hours to two days per week. Ms Mhairi Claire Shaw has been appointed to fill the other three days per week of this permanent post. I am also expecting three additional temporary teachers to be appointed. However, I am unlikely to know who these teachers will be before the summer break.

It is with great joy that I can share the news of the safe arrival of baby Mary Grace Din. Mrs Din and baby Mary are both well.

This will be a busy and exciting term. As always, I am very grateful for your support.
