

School Uniform

Wednesday 18 August 9:30-1:30

Thursday 19 August 9:30-2:00

Friday 20 August 9:30-2:00

From Monday 23 August All children will attend full time from 9:00-3:00

Until and including Friday 20 August, P1 children can be accompanied by one adult in the playground until they become used to staff and staff get to know the children and the adults who collect them. Please ensure that you social distance while in the playground.
