elcome back to all our children and staff. I have been so impressed with the calm start that we have had to session 2021-22 here in St Brigid's Primary School. Arrangements for PE

Children should not wear jeans, crop tops or tight clothing. PE days are not an opportunity for dress down days.

Entering the School Building/Playground August 2021 Parents and carers will still not be permitted to come into the playground. Each child should be accompanied by 1 parent/carer. The gate will be opened for a few minutes in the morning and afternoon to allow P5b & P6a access to and from the main entrance.
