

Breakfast Club

Free school meals P1-P5

A reminder that all P1-P5 children are entitled to a free school meal. Those children who qualify for a free school meal in P6-P7 must apply on-line at www.glasgow.gov.uk at the moment.

Meals can be purchased at a cost of £1:90 per day and breakfast club is £2 per day.

You do not need to register for the Breakfast Club and it is open from 8:00am and is accessed through the infant playground, with children going straight into the dinner hall.

- All P1 children should start on Wednesday 17 August 2022

 Thursday 18 August 9:30-1:30
 Friday 19 August 9:30-1:30
 Monday 22 August 9:30-2:00
 Tuesday 23 August 9:30-2:00
- From Wednesday 24 August all children will attend full time from 9:00-3:00
- On the first day 2 parents/carers maximum can accompany their child into the school so that they can take a photo of their child on their special day and also to see the classroom.
- Until and including Friday 26 August, P1 children may be accompanied by one adult in the playground until they become used to staff and staff get to know the children and the adults who collect them. From Monday 29 August there should be no adults in the playground. Thank you in advance for your cooperation with this.


