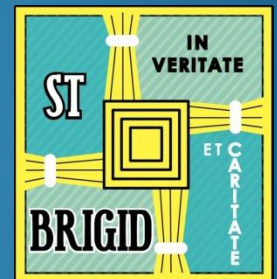

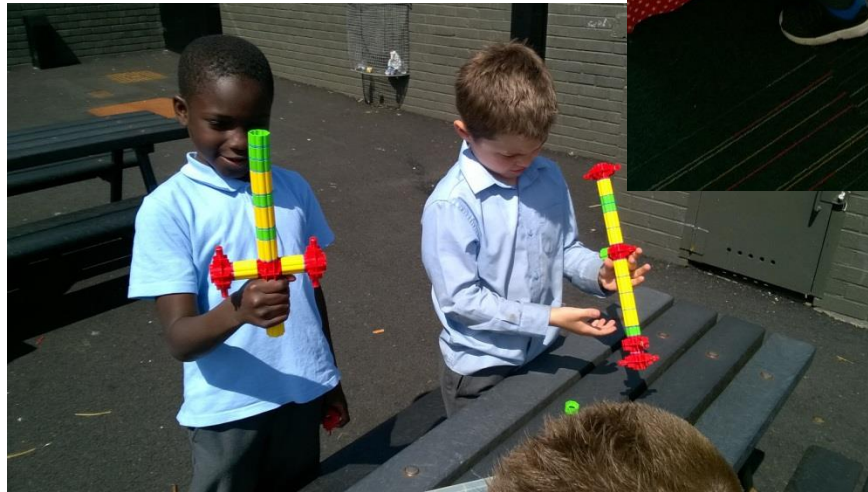

- ✓ Literacy & Language including Modern Languages –
  - ✓ Phonological Awareness
  - ✓ If I can hear it, I can say it
  - ✓ If I can say it, I can read it
  - ✓ If I can read it, I can write it

Phonics – sounds/common words  
Song/ Rhyme/Three stories per day  
Taught how to form letters  
Have a go writing

# School Uniform

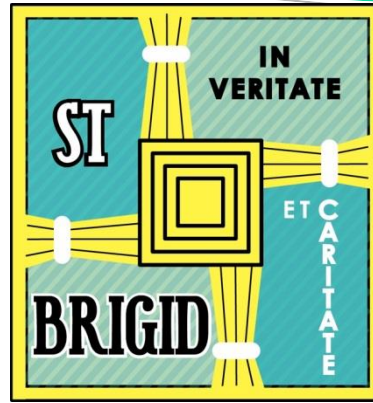
# What can you do to help?

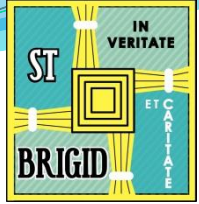

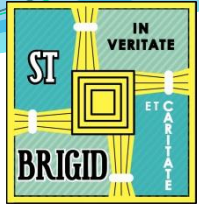
