





#### **School Uniform**

- √ Blue school shirt and school tie
- √ Mid grey skirt or tailored school trousers
- √ Mid grey v-neck sweater or cardigan
- √ Plain grey knee high or ankle socks
- √ Black school shoes (velcro, please)
- √ Simple black gym shoes
- √ Pale blue polo shirt and dark blue shorts for PE
- √ Simple hair accessories e.g. plain navy and/or yellow ribbons, school hair band or scrunchie
- √ Label everything with First & Second name


#### What can you do to help?


