



Home Learning Survey Results January 2021

There were 20 responses of which only 17 can be shared due to confidentiality.

- Showbie is working well thank you.
- I think the voice notes are important its certainly helping my daughter engage so would be good if both classes could have that. My children are refusing to do the optional extras because they are optional even though we have plenty of time to complete these tasks. Can I just say I think the way Miss Anderson is delivering the tasks is fantastic and within the chat function she is very active and responsive with the class. They always know she is there to support them. Thank you
- My child is doing his showbie assigned work in school. He is not a confident reader and so large amounts of written text makes him panic. He is also reluctant to ask for help from Teachers he does not know. I have raised this with his own class teacher who has been so supportive in looking at strategies to support my child, reduce feelings of being overwhelmed and target some work to child's specific interests. This has been a fantastic support to me and great example of home/school partnership working.
- My child enjoys the work set for her and feedback is excellent. She loves to hear her feedback. (Not just during lockdown). Overall it has worked well for us.

- Microsoft team app could be used to do presentation with children
- If possible could the work be available 24hrs before for each day, as both parents are working this would make it easier for our family to prepare for the next days learning.
- I am aware that the school day starts at 9am however it would be good to have the days work uploaded a little earlier or possibly the evening before in order for this to be worked around our families working from home schedule.
- We have found that although a good resource, navigating and trying to make answers fit into spaces in showbie often takes just as long as the actual work and can be a bit of a source of frustration so we have replicated a lot of stuff on to paper for * to complete. We were just wondering if there was any chance of the following day's work being 'released' the night before in order to allow us to prep in advance. Appreciate it may not always be possible but sometimes we can see the lesson is there but it's just not 'unlocked' yet.
- Sometimes have issues with voice notes as they fail to load
- Maybe sort the folders in order better but seriously not a problem staff are all Doing excellent
- For students in higher classes, teacher can upload their videos by explaining the topic/sums. In my opinion, they should include a lay out of the new task that has been given to them.
- Would be good to have access to all of the work for the week. This would enable me to print
 off worksheets and plan our schooling. I work full time and rely on Grand Parents for child
 minding, They struggle with showbie- if I had access I could ensure my kids go with work
 sheets
- Showbie voice note not working at times.
- Not sure if this is a possibility but maybe a kind of project or topic that the kids could do research on.
- I feel the amount of work is perfect for my child as if it was too much he would lose concentration as in his home environment. I also work from home just now and if was any more I feel would be struggling or rushing to get through. I like that the activities for the day are unlocked at the same time and not set times.
- You are do amazing job 2
- No everyone's doing fab. The teachers definitely need to keep in contact via telephone call every week or every 2 weeks at least.

School response:

- We have unlocked work the at least the day before to help families to plan.
- We are currently sending out information about 'live' check ins for children.
- Class teachers will continue to phone children at least fortnightly.
- Senior staff will continue to phone as and when appropriate.
