

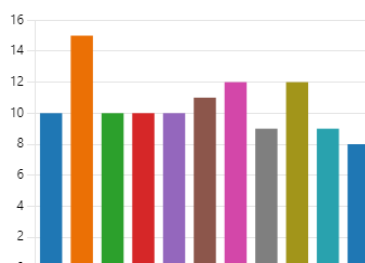
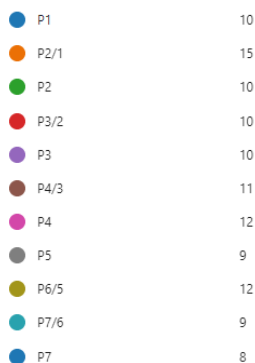
Parents' Questionnaire – Sharing the Learning
